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Bavarian Minister-President visits Everllence in Augsburg

Dr Markus Söder recognizes corporate headquarters as strong industrial hub for future technologies from Bavaria

On July 17, Bavarian Minister-President Dr Markus Söder, visited the Everllence site in Augsburg. Everllence CEO Dr Uwe Lauber, the company's Executive Board, and Astrid Kluge, Chair of the Group Works Council, welcomed the Minister-President at the company's newly redesigned PrimeServ Academy.
